ABSTRACT FOR ORAL PRESENTATION

Title must be concise, informative and only the first letter is capitalized (Times New Roman font size 16 pt)

Abstract.

The abstract should be an informative synopsis/summary of your manuscript. All abstracts for original articles should follow the structured format, with the heading of Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusion. Abstract for Case Series should follow the structured format, with Introduction, Case Series and Conclusion heading. Abstract for Short Communications, Review article, Commentary and Case report should follow the unstructured format. No need to divide the abstract into different sections. The word count should not exceed 250 words. The abstract text should be formatted using Times New Roman font size 11 pt with 1.5 (one and half) line spacing between lines, and on A4 paper (210 mm x 297 mm).

Keywords: up to five words, separated by comma

References

References should consist of initial and writers' names, names of journals or title of books, volumes, editors (if any), publishers and their cities, years of publication, and pages. All writer's names have to be mentioned.
